LOS BOSQUES

Los Bosques (Montevideo, Uruguay) is a duo formed by Diego Traverso (Sante Les Amis) and Tejo Mattioli (La Teja Pride). The project explores the dialogue between the city and the environment through electronic music. Their soundscapes range from danceable beats to ambient textures. Their live shows include samples from old vinyl records, synthesizers, guitars, drum machines, and scratching. Their music blends organic electronica with downtempo, infused with Latin American influences, always emphasizing rhythm and groove — the foundation from which atmospheres and melodies are built.

Their debut album, *Con qué sueñan los bosques*, was released in 2019. They won a Graffiti Award for *Monte Nativo*, released in 2022 by the U.S.-based label The Acrylic Label. In April 2023, they released *Ecos del río*, showcasing a more electronic facet: a mix of synthesized textures, candombe-trip, looped songs, and Uruguayan psychedelia. In May 2024, they released their latest album *La Lengua de los Pájaros*, blending hip hop with local genres from the Río de la Plata region.

LOS BOSQUES / LA LENGUA DE LOS PÁJAROS (2024)

Inspired by birdsong, Los Bosques use this metaphor to immerse themselves in the voices of animals and natural sounds — native birds, crickets — fused with traditional sounds from the Río de la Plata. Milonga, cumbia, candombe, tango all blend with a lo-fi aesthetic. Acoustic and electric guitars, drums, bandoneon, piano, accordion, AM-radio-style trumpets, and ambient sounds recorded in Montevideo are all layered with hip hop beats to give meaning to the language of the birds.

Guests include poet Circe Maia, winner of numerous awards including the Federico García Lorca International Poetry Prize (2023), who at age 91 lends her voice to the poem "El árbol del fondo". Local composer and producer Lucia Severino plays accordion on "Paro general". Juan Gutiérrez (Chill&Go), based in Mexico City, co-produced and composed the lofi cumbia "Pan de Azúcar", the album's first single.

LOS BOSQUES/ ECOS DEL RIO (2023)

Ecos del Río is an album with water as its narrative thread — a tribute and a warning about a world at risk. Drawing on Latin American sounds and electronic music elements, Los Bosques create "folktronica" with synthesizers, field recordings, guitars, drum machines, drums, and the sound of the sea. House, lofi, candombe, funk, and techno merge. It's also a manifesto of their live sound: an invitation to dance and let nature take over the speakers. Guest vocals include Vicky Ripa, Laura Chinelli, and rapper El Kb.

LOS BOSQUES/ MONTE NATIVO (2022)

Monte Nativo refers to native forest ecosystems — a metaphor for Los Bosques' search for inspiration in traditional sounds from the Río de la Plata, especially those rooted in Montevideo's musical history. Milonga, cumbia, candombe, tango all fuse within a lo-fi aesthetic. Acoustic guitars, drums, bandoneon, trumpet, saxophone, AM radio, native birdsong and cricket field recordings — all layered over hip hop beats to bring Monte Nativo to life.
